



The Ogunquit Residents Alliance began the Fuel Initiative in 2020, with the goal of providing, through group purchase, fuel (oil, propane and/or kerosene) at reduced costs to participants.

Customers may be residents or business owners in Ogunquit and Cape Neddick. You do not have to be ORA members to participate.

The first year included contacts with 46 families who were offered discounted rates from the two of many vendors researched.

Thirty-five (35) families did participate in the 2020-2021 and 2021-2022 program, saving thousands of dollars.

With fuel prices in flux this year, 2022-2023, we have 25 families participating in the Propane program. The remaining 25 contacts who use oil are waiting for prices to decrease.

Anyone who wants a reminder for next year's program, please send us your email. The program cut off this year was 8/31/22.

All participants and new enrollees will be contacted in May or June, 2023.
